Mustangs are gathered from both BLM and state-controlled lands. Thousands of young, healthy horses are available for adoption through the BLM and many have been in holding facilities for far too long. Mustangs gathered from state-controlled lands are not protected and can go directly to auction where they can be sold for slaughter. The Mustang Project's goal is to adopt and train as many of these mustangs as possible, either for use in the program or to be adopted by the public.

For our February 9 meeting, we will have a guest speaker from Handi-Riders, a local non-profit organization that provides a therapeutic horseback riding program for children and adults with special needs.
