RULES & REGULATIONS

- Class fees are \$4.99 per class. Check and cash will be collected at the time of registration. **NO REFUNDS.**
- All dogs must be on leash.
- CEA representatives have the right to split a class. They also have the right to ask an unsafe or unsound horse to leave the grounds. We ask that no foul language be use. If anyone acts out of manner, they will be asked to leave. The decisions made by the CEA representatives are final. Safety of the horse and rider is the overriding goal of this show. Only humane bits and tack will be allowed.
- The dressage ring and round pen will be available for warm ups.
- Show attire is not mandatory. We ask that you wear a collared shirt of any length. Boots are required. Any rider 18 years and under must wear a SEI/ASTM rated helmet when mounted: English or Western.
- The youth classes are for contestants 17 years and under, as of January 1, 2020.
- Points towards Hi Point will be kept for all classes except Lead Line and Ride a Buck Classes.
- Basic Trail Class – To avoid excessive delays, each rider will only have **one** opportunity to complete each obstacle on the course.
